USGA Resolution Regarding Harassment in Powelton Village

RECOGNIZING

That Drexel University is an institution of higher education; and that Drexel therefore has a responsibility as an institution of higher education to prepare its students to be upstanding members of society;

EMPHASIZING

That Drexel University is undeniably an active part of society, especially Powelton Village, through its geography, employment and civic involvement:

HAVING SEEN

Recent intolerable events by members and students of the Drexel community including:

- On January 1, 2000, an enraged Drexel student screamed, "N__ers get killed in their own cribs!" smashed many beer bottles, and broke several limbs off an ornamental tree;
- On January 10, 2000, three white, college-aged males repeatedly shouted anti-gay slurs on Winter and Natrona streets and smashed a TV
 tube lying the sidewalk. They threatened a gay man with physical violence.
- On Feb 10, 2000, a resident of Powelton village discovered a desecrated rainbow flag torn down, urinated on, and inscribed with four lines of obscene text in the green, yellow, orange, and red color bands: "Kill Gays, Dy_s, and F_ts Burn in Hell."

LOOKING UPON

That behavior as unacceptable and detrimental to our campus community; and

APPLATIDING

The work and progress of members of the Straight and Gay Alliance (SAGA), as well as certain instructors from the English Learning Center (ELC);

The USGA, representing the Student Body through its elected officers,

RESOLVES

- . To support the progress of student organizations and members of the Drexel Community.
- 2. To not condone the recent events of behavior by members of the Drexel Community.
- 3. To publicize our stance with the hope that behavior will cease.
- 4. To encourage residents of Powelton Village, which encompasses Drexel students and members of the Powelton Village Civic Association (PVCA), to form a neighborhood watch in the hopes of preventing future incidents.
- 5. To encourage addition proactive initiatives to prevent future events.
